Longer-term Outcomes

Improved Key Stage 2 assessment outcomes which allows pupils to successfully access the wider curriculum at Key Stage 3 and beyond.

Pupils remain engaged with education, reducing the risk of academic exclusion and NEET status.

Pupils participate confidently in society, reducing the risk of social exclusion and criminal behaviour.

Short-term Outcomes

Increased pupil confidence in reading and in participating in the classroom

Children make significant progress in their reading accuracy and comprehension

Increased parental confidence in supporting their child's learning at home

Improved learner self concept - children enjoy reading

435 disadvantaged children struggling with literacy complete our programmes in 2020/21

Parents of pupils receiving teaching engage with their child's learning during the programme
