Longer-term Outcomes

Improved Key Stage 2 assessment outcomes which allows pupils to successfully access the wider curriculum at Key Stage 3 and beyond.

Pupils remain engaged with education, reducing the risk of academic exclusion and NEET status.

Pupils participate confidently in society, reducing the risk of social exclusion and criminal behaviour.

Short-term Outcomes

Increased pupil confidence participating in the classroom

Children improve their fluency in mental maths and calculation

Increased parental confidence in supporting their child's learning at home

Improved learner self concept - children enjoy maths
