Quest for Learning is a local Oxfordshire charity which has been working with partner primary schools across the county since 1995 to provide supplementary tutoring for children who are struggling with reading or maths. We offer three tried-and-tested programmes: ReadingQuest for KS1, BookQuest for KS2, and NumSkills, which can span both Key Stages.

Unlike many other charities, we employ qualified and experienced primary school teachers to deliver our tutoring, so schools can be confident that their tutor has the pedagogical knowledge and hands-on experience to deliver a truly adaptive learning experience for each child, rather than relying on a heavily scripted and inflexible scheme of work.
